**When a family faces financial hardship, one of the first things sacrificed is a child's education.**

Out of school, a child is more vulnerable to exploitation and violence. Education gives a child the chance to escape poverty and provide for themselves. It benefits them, their families, and their communities.

# EDUCATION

## **EDUCATE 2 GIRLS**

## **EDUCATE A GIRL \$75**

Every girl has the right to an education. Too often, families can't afford to keep their daughters in school and feel compelled to consider early marriage. Staying in school delays marriage and childbirth, and provides girls with an opportunity to become self-sufficient. Books, learning materials, and access to education allow two girls to pursue their dreams.

## **EDUCATE DISPLACED CHILDREN**

Children displaced by war, natural disasters, and other emergencies lose access to education, which limits their ability to succeed later in life. Provide a temporary classroom within a displacement camp for multiple children whose schooling has been disrupted.

## **SCHOOL LUNCHES**

Lunch provided at school is sometimes the only meal a child receives each day. Provide a month of school lunches for two children so they can focus on learning and not their hungry bellies.

# SUSTAINABILITY

## CHICKS

Chicks grow into productive egg-layers, providing protein-rich eggs to feed a child. Extra eggs can be sold to cover health and living essentials.

## 1 COW

A single cow can change a child's life by providing protein and calcium while offering an opportunity to sell milk that finances a child's education and healthcare.

## 3 GOATS

Every day, goats provide nourishing milk to feed children. As a herd grows, excess milk and baby goats can be sold to pay for medicine, education, and living essentials.

## 2 GOATS + 1 SHEEP

With two goats and a sheep, a family can focus on financial stability. The sale of milk, offspring, wool, and fertilizer can generate an income to overcome poverty.

**Livestock, farming crops, tools, and training give a child access to nutritious food, as well as wool and feathers to keep warm.**

Each animal gift also includes animal care training and veterinary support, including vaccinations against disease. When a family supports themselves by selling or trading animals, their children are able to attend school and access healthcare. This is a gift that keeps on giving year after year!

### **1 GOAT + 2 CHICKS**

Goats and chicks provide an essential daily supply of milk and eggs to help nourish a growing child. Livestock can be bred to expand the income of the family.

### **2 GOATS + 1 COW**

A cow and goats are the foundation of a thriving dairy farm. Vital for children, milk quenches thirst, and provides essential vitamins and minerals that can stave off malnutrition.

### **LIVESTOCK BUNDLE**

Provide a child with a thriving stable including a cow, a donkey, two goats, and two sheep. These animals will provide sustainable food and marketable items year after year.

## STOCK A CHILD'S FARM

Many children rely on livestock and crops to survive. Stock a child's farm with seeds and fruit trees for a drought-resistant garden. Farms also receive a goat and some chicks, tools, and a water source for irrigating crops and feeding livestock.

## SEEDS AND TOOLS

Quality native seeds can help a farm thrive. A child and their family will also receive tools such as hoes, shovels, and watering cans, along with instruction in agriculture techniques and rich organic fertilizer to help their farm succeed.

## DROUGHT RESISTANT FARMING ESSENTIALS

Help a child's farm thrive during a life-threatening drought with farming essentials. Give drought-tolerant seeds, higher yielding crops that mature quickly, irrigation tools, as well as training on planting practices for arid conditions. A literal lifesaver for children in dry regions.

### **DISPLACED CHILD EMERGENCY KIT**

Children displaced by conflict or climate disasters leave everything behind. Give a child a hygiene kit — loaded with basics like soap, hand sanitizer, toothpaste and toothbrushes, shampoo, and diapers — bundled with an emergency blanket, sleeping mat, tarp, and rope to make a temporary shelter.

### **DROUGHT RESPONSE KIT**

Climate emergencies like drought significantly affect drier areas of the world with devastating results on food security for children. Help a child survive a drought by providing emergency food, high-nutrient peanut paste for malnutrition, and clean water.

### **FLOOD RESPONSE KIT**

Floods destroy homes, schools, and community infrastructure. This kit provides food, clean water, medicine for waterborne illnesses like cholera, emergency shelter, and a blanket to a child affected by floods.

**In times of humanitarian crisis, children are at their most vulnerable.**

Sometimes separated from family, they're torn from everything they've known. Forced to flee with nothing but what they can carry, the disruption and trauma can change a child forever.

# CLIMATE, CONFLICT, AND EMERGENCIES

## **CARE FOR A CHILD FLEEING CONFLICT**

**NEW**

Children fleeing conflict have been ripped from their homes, schools, and sometimes their families. Provide a child with the care they need to endure the chaos of conflict: emergency food, medicine, a clean water kit, trauma support, and access to education.

## **CARE FOR AN UNACCOMPANIED CHILD FLEEING CONFLICT**

**NEW**

Unaccompanied children who are separated from or have lost their parents are among those displaced. These children are at extreme risk of violence, exploitation, trafficking, and health issues. Provide alternative care arrangements, family reunification services, healthcare, psycho-social support and education for a child facing crisis alone.

## EMERGENCY FOOD

Children caught in concurrent crises such as drought, soaring food prices, and war are in desperate need of reliable, nutritious food to keep them healthy. Provide emergency food for a child living on the brink of famine.

## CHILD SAFE SPACE

Children escaping conflict are at greater risk of violence and exploitation. Support adult-supervised spaces where a child is able to play with toys and other children, access schooling and trauma counselling, and feel cared for and safe.

## EMERGENCY HEALTH UNIT

Put a world class team of doctors and nurses – equipped by a global network of supply hubs – at an ill or injured child's side, giving them the treatment they need within 72 hours of a crisis.

# RECONCILIATION

**Colonization and deep systemic racial biases have put Indigenous children in Canada at a severe disadvantage.**

This context has created intergenerational trauma and barriers to accessing appropriate healthcare, education, and traditional languages.

Take a positive step toward reconciliation by supporting Indigenous-led initiatives that benefit children from coast to coast to coast.

## MENTAL WELLNESS KIT

Providing access to culturally sensitive mental health support is a priority for many Indigenous communities. It is critical for the physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual wellbeing of children. Support a child to enhance their emotional and interpersonal skills with a mental wellness app combined with local programs grounded in Indigenous knowledge.

## EMERGENCY BACKPACKS

The increasing number of climate emergencies, like extreme weather, flooding and forest fires, regularly force entire Indigenous communities in northern Canada to be evacuated. Provide an emergency backpack that contains a hygiene kit, ID bracelet, flashlight, toy, notebook and pen, along with emergency training to keep a child safe.

## **INDIGENOUS LANGUAGE LESSONS**

There are approximately 70 Indigenous languages currently spoken in Canada — it is projected that only three will still be spoken in 30 years. Alongside local Indigenous partners, support the creation of audio/video resources and books to revitalize Indigenous languages and help a child reclaim the connection to their spirituality, culture and identity.

## **LITERACY BOOSTING BOOKS**

By reading books from Indigenous authors and illustrators, Indigenous children can embrace their heritage and find acceptance, particularly in remote communities where resources may be limited. You can give a child the gift of books that represent them, their stories, and their communities.

## **BABY BUNDLE**

Partner with Indigenous-led health and social services to provide a baby bundle to parents who are expecting or caring for an infant. Each kit includes diapers, wipes, lotion, clothing, a digital thermometer, warm blanket, and plush toy.

## MALNUTRITION TREATMENT

The number of children experiencing deadly malnutrition is increasing at a staggering rate. Provide life-saving treatment for children over several weeks, including high-nutrient food (peanut paste), fortified milk, and medical care such as antibiotics.

## PNEUMONIA TREATMENT

Pneumonia is one of the leading causes of death for children under the age of five, often made worse by poor nutrition. Provide emergency care for a child suffering from pneumonia including antibiotics, oxygen therapy, and vaccinations.

## MEDICINE AND VACCINES

Antibiotics, rehydration salts, zinc, malaria medicines, and vaccines for diseases such as measles, polio, and tetanus, paired with training for health workers and parents, provide children under the age of five with life-saving protection.

Many of the world's leading causes of death among children under five can be addressed simply by giving a child access to clean water.

Clean water and medical care for a displaced child, community or entire school protects children from deadly diseases and critical illnesses like malnutrition, and let's them focus on learning and other activities.

Help provide clean running water for a school and allow an entire community of children to benefit from its health impact. Clean water protects from diarrheal diseases which are leading causes of death among children.

# CHILD HEALTH

## CLEAN WATER KIT

A Clean Water Kit — including soap, a bucket, and water-purifying tablets — helps to maintain hygiene and health. This can be a literal lifesaver for a child displaced by conflict or overwhelmed by climate disasters.

## CLEAN WATER PROJECT

Give access to clean water! Help drill a well, install a new water pump or build a latrine for a community to reduce the spread of deadly diseases. With a clean water source nearby, children can go to school instead of walking long distances to collect water for their families.

# CHILD PROTECTION

**Every child has the right to be safe and free from harm.**

Protect a child at risk of violence, trafficking and abuse, fight against early marriage and childbirth, and provide education and life-saving healthcare to adolescent mothers and their babies.

## **PROTECT A CHILD FROM VIOLENCE**

Shield a child from violence and exploitation by supporting programs that work with parents, communities, schools, and governments to increase child protection services, address domestic violence, and eliminate corporal punishment.

## PROTECT AN UNACCOMPANIED CHILD

Protect a vulnerable child who has lost or been separated from their parents or family due to conflict, natural disaster or disease. This gift provides an unaccompanied child with adult protection and essentials such as food, shelter, medical care, and trauma counselling.

## PROTECT A GIRL FROM EARLY AND FORCED MARRIAGE

Child, early and forced marriage ends a girl's education, limits her ability to find a good job, forces adult responsibilities, and puts her at risk of early pregnancies and maternal death. Support work with girls, their parents, and community leaders to change social norms, helping to end this gender-based violence.

## ADOLESCENT MOTHER AND BABY HEALTH


Across the globe, many girls have babies before their bodies are ready. In many cases, they are not permitted to see a doctor while pregnant. Support programs that educate parents and adolescents about sexual and reproductive health and rights. This gift also provides access to healthcare for young women whose lives are in danger from childbirth.
