

Clean, safe water from dug and drilled wells, along with public latrines and water pumps, dramatically improve community health, sanitation and agriculture. With clean water, children who would otherwise miss out on school to fetch water in dangerous conditions can remain in the classroom. This share of clean water projects minimizes the spread of diseases and protects against some of the world's leading causes of death.

STOCK A MEDICAL CLINIC

Supplies like stethoscopes, blood pressure monitors, thermometers, measuring tapes, syringes, gauze and bandages are lifesaving in the hands of health workers in rural communities with limited options.

Care for orphans and vulnerable children provides these girls and boys with essentials like food, shelter, education and counselling. In addition, our programs target the age-specific needs of children affected by HIV/AIDS.

BICYCLES

In remote communities where ambulances are rare, bicycles give health care workers the ability to reach sick children with lifesaving medicine and treatment. Two wheels can make all the difference for a child on the brink of survival.

CLEAN WATER KITS

A clean water kit — including soap, a bucket and water-purifying tabs — helps maintain hygiene and health. This can be a literal lifesaver for families when they have been displaced by conflict or overwhelmed by climate disasters.

A mobile health clinic rushes medical teams, equipment and medicine to children after a catastrophic emergency. It also travels to remote communities to immunize and screen children for common but deadly illnesses.

Antibiotics, rehydration salts, zinc and vaccines for diseases such as measles, polio and tetanus — paired with training for health workers and parents — provide children under the age of five with vital defenses.

COVID-19 and the increasing number of climate emergencies in Canada have shed light on the inequalities Indigenous children already face. Disruptions to their education, social development and cultural support networks are negatively affecting their physical and mental wellbeing. These Gifts of Joy provide essential resources to support Indigenous children.



MENTAL WELLNESS KIT

Access to mental health support is critical for the physical, emotional, mental and spiritual wellbeing of children and a priority for Indigenous communities. This mental wellness app, grounded in Indigenous knowledge, is combined with local programs to support Indigenous children in enhancing their emotional and interpersonal skills in a culturally sensitive way.

EMERGENCY BACKPACKS

Flooding and forest fires are becoming more frequent and intense due to climate change, and entire communities in northern Canada are evacuated on a regular basis. Emergency backpacks are provided to schools in high-risk areas, along with emergency training. They contain a hygiene kit, ID bracelet, flashlight, toy, notebook and pen to keep children safe and comfortable in emergencies.

LITERACY-BOOSTING BOOKS

Indigenous representation, perspectives and stories play a large role in providing Indigenous children with a sense of peace and acceptance. Books by Indigenous authors and illustrators support Indigenous children's learning in remote communities where access to age- and culturally appropriate reading materials is limited.

The Healing Through the Arts program provides kits with creative supplies, such as paints, pencils, charcoal and sewing materials, along with emotional and cultural support to assist Indigenous children in strengthening mental resilience and interpersonal abilities while maintaining their cultural identity.

We partner with Indigenous-led health and social services to provide baby bundle kits for parents who are expecting or caring for an infant.
